REMINDER FOR AFTERNOON COLLECTION OF BOYS AT HOCKEY SHOP ENTRANCE

NEW ARRANGEMENTS FOR AFTERNOON COLLECTION OF BOYS FROM OXFORD STREET

Some issues have arisen around behaviour and safety of boys waiting in Oxford Street after school.

As a result, the following rules will be implemented with immediate effect:
