EXAMINATIONS JUNE 2016

21 April 2016

Please note that we have shifted the start of the upcoming June examination from 30 May 2016 to 1 June for Grade 7's and 3 June for Grades 4 - 6. The examinations will end on 10 June 2016 for Grades 4 - 7. This development was necessitated by a directive from the Western Cape Education Department which determined the starting date for the 2016 June examinations. This information was not available to us at the time of doing strategic planning for 2016.

We apologise for the inconvenience and disruption it might cause in the process of preparing for the examination. Your son will come home with a hardcopy of his examination timetable, please return the reply slip attached.

ARRANGEMENTS DURING EXAMINATIONS

21 April 2016

The examination session will end at 13h00 from Monday to Thursday after which boys will attend extra-murals until 15h00. Boys not attending extra-murals will be supervised in study sessions until school ends (14h45). No boys may leave before the end of the school day. The ending time for Fridays remains as per usual. An extra-mural programme for the exam week will be sent home next week.

PROTOCOL FOR PARENTS ATTENDING SPORT

Please be aware of the following expectations of schools and their coaches and referees.

- Parents or non-participants may not enter the field of play during stoppages or at half-time. Teams organise water stops etc. Coaches need to speak to boys

without parents "hanging on". Please do not supply your son with food or water during a game.
