FILM & PUBLICATIONS BOARD VISIT WBJS

As part of our ongoing commitment to educate learners about cyber safety, we were visited by The Film and Publications Board on Monday, May 8th. In a special assembly, they outlined 3 key responsibilities:

To provide consumer advice so that adults make informed viewing, reading and gaming choices for themselves and their children.

To protect children from exposure to potentially disturbing, harmful or inappropriate material.

To protect children from sexual exploitation.

The boys were given tips using the internet safely, how to report instances of cyberbullying, the dangers of interacting with strangers, and why age restrictions should be respected.

It was clear that many boys younger than 13 have social media accounts with unsupervised internet access. We urge parents to be vigilant
