### **MID-YEAR EXAMS**

28 May 2017

The mid-year exams start on Monday 12 June and end Tuesday 20 June. By now you should have received your son's exam timetable and study scope.

Please take note of the following arrangements during this period.

School will close at 13h00 for all boys.

There will be no sports practices, homework hour or extra murals. It is imperative that all boys are collected at 13h00.

There will be no sports fixtures.

All extra murals and sports practices will commence on Tuesday 20 June and will run from 13h30 until 14h45 on this day.

The normal school programme will commence on Wednesday 21 June, ie normal school hours and extra-curricular programme

Please stress the importance of thorough preparation to your boys. Try to explain the difference between exams and normal class activities.

### **Boys must be made aware of the following exam writing conditions:**

28 May 2017

No form of communication, verbal, gestures or otherwise, is permitted, ie a learner may not ask another learner for a pencil or eraser, etc. Please ensure your son has all the stationery he needs to complete the exam.

No walking is allowed during the exam.

Boys are not allowed to have books/study notes on their person during the exam. Ensure notes are packed away before the exam starts.

Boys are under controlled test conditions until the end of the session. If he finishes before the time he still needs to behave in a manner consistent with the expectations of exam conditions.

Toilet breaks are allowed, it is better for boys to go to the toilet before the exam starts.

A learner must refrain from causing a disturbance or distraction during the exam

Please note amended end time for rugby practices and Grease rehearsals for those boys involved.

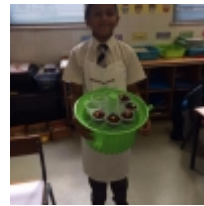
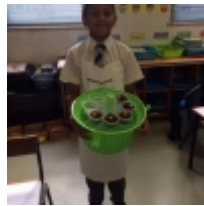
